We have a number of other planned projects for the next 12 months to ensure we continually improve the Community.

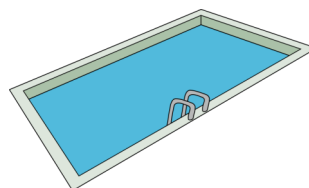


Mail Flag
